2022-23 Seminars for Biological Sciences Majors

If you are majoring in Biological Science, interested in taking Humanities Core, and are eligible to take HUMAN 1AS according to your Writing Placement notification from the Testing Center, consider enrolling in one of the following two seminars that have been reserved for students just like you!

Humanities Core is a yearlong sequence of two paired courses, a 4-credit lecture and a 4-credit writing seminar. The seminars reserved for BioSci majors are as follows:

- VIII. International/Global Issues [1 course]
